

## Transit Tips

1. Walk in well lit areas to and from the LRT stations or transit centers, and always be aware of your surroundings. Know where you can get help on your route, such as stores or businesses, if needed.
2. Do not leave personal items or bags unattended. Large crowds are a popular place for pickpockets. Be aware of distractions, such as bumps or loud arguments. They may be staged to distract you while a thief takes your wallet or handbag. Carry only what you need. Do not carry unnecessary items such as personal documents, extra money, or jewelry if not needed.
3. If you feel someone is following you use, the Emergency Help Phone or the Security button on the payphones and inform the Communications Officer of your concern. You will be monitored by CCTV and a PSO will be dispatched to your location to assist you.
4. ETSSD encourages patrons to report any suspicious activity or criminal behavior they encounter by pressing the blue help phone button, the Security button on a specially equipped payphone, or speaking directly to an ETS employee.
5. In case of an Emergency situation, listen carefully for announcements and follow instructions for your safety and security.
